Line-X Bed Liners

Dear Southeast Valley Line-X,

I have a fleet of 26 Toyota vehicles used for swimming pool service and repair. All of the trucks were originally sprayed with a spray-in liner from another company. I didn't realize the deleterious effects the chemicals would have on the bed liners until years later.

I've always liked the spray-in liners over the plastic drop in ones, but after I started seeing the problems I was having I felt like I had no choice but to go that route.

One day one of my supervisors came in and gave me a sample of the Line-X material to look at. I tossed it to the side and gave it no thought, thinking it would be just like the other spray-in material we already used. A month or so went by and we decided to put it through a test.

We filled a dish with an undiluted high strength chlorine bleach and put the sample of material in it for the weekend. We then filled another dish with hydrochloric acid and placed the other sample in it, and also left it sit for the weekend.

When I came back on Monday I expected the samples to be ruined. I was shocked to find both samples in perfect condition, and the material uncompromised. It was then that I became a believer in the product. Thank goodness I don't have to resort to those plastic drop-in liners.
